SOME KEY FACTS

Manor Road Co-operative Nursery School Inc. was founded in 1937 and has been in continuous operation in the same location since that time. We are the oldest Parent Co-operative Nursery School in Canada.

Our primary goal is to provide an environment of trust, one that stimulates a child's physical, social, emotional and intellectual growth. Teachers and Parents work in partnership for the benefit of each child. Play is central to the child's development and our program emphasizes this with creative art, music and movement skills. An enriching mixture of facilities and opportunities allows each child to develop at their own pace.

Limited enrollment (24 children per morning) and our large premises (including our own fenced playground) give each child plenty of space to grow. Our teachers are qualified Early Childhood Educators and operate within the guidelines of the Day Nurseries Act. The school staff is supplemented by parents, who are an essential part of the program.

General Information:

- Children from 2 ½ to 4 ½ years of age are welcome.
- A 2, 3 or 5 morning program is available.
- Hours are from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m.
- School term runs from September to June and closes for Winter Break, March Break and statutory holidays.
- Two early childhood educators and up to 3 parents are on duty daily (depending on enrollment).
- We are a member of the Toronto & District Parent Co-operative Preschool Corporation (PCPC)

Parent duty days offer the parent a unique opportunity to be a part of their child's first school experience. Each family contributes to the school as a member of either the elected executive board or of a committee and in supporting and fund-raising events.

Participation by parents ensures that the school will continue to be a learning experience for everyone involved – children, parents and teachers.
